It will be held in Khalifa University in Abu Dhabi in United Arab Emirates, Khalifa University (KU). The technical advisory committee contains 10 scientists of the most well-known professors from all over the world,

It has received 143 applications from 35 countries, with most of the applications coming from leading robotics laboratories at top universities. MBZIRC 2017 will consist of three challenges and a triathlon type Grand Challenge, Paris-Saclay team is the only selected team located in France and will participate to challenge II."
